



ROMSEY PRIMARY SCHOOL CHRISTIAN RELIGIOUS EDUCATION POLICY

Rationale:

At Romsey Primary School, we provide the opportunity for students to participate in a Religious Instruction Program.

Goal:

To follow the legislative requirement of providing Religious Instruction in government schools as authorised by Section 2.2.11 of the Education and Training Reform Act 2006.

Guidelines:

- If approached by Department of Education and Training accredited instructors the school will offer Religious Instruction to students
- Parental permission for participation must be obtained when the program is offered. Religious Instruction will be scheduled into the whole school timetable through negotiation with principal and instructors.
- Religious Instruction lessons will be of a maximum of 30 minutes duration per week.
- Internal class and/or Professional Learning Team arrangements will be made for the alternate instruction of students not attending Religious Instruction. You Can Do It sessions will be conducted for non-Religious Instruction students.
- All Religious Instruction lessons will be supervised by a teacher.

Evaluation:

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's three-year review.
