



ROMSEY PRIMARY SCHOOL PARENT HELPERS POLICY

Rationale:

Romsey Primary School believes there should be a positive and supportive relationship between the school and home. The school values and encourages the support and interaction of the parent community within the school setting.

Goals:

- To develop and improve the partnership between the school and home.
- To build relationships and facilitate communication between school and home.
- To increase parental involvement in the education of students.

Guidelines:

- A parent helpers program in literacy and numeracy will be provided. This program will include explanation of a confidentiality agreement prior to classroom involvement.
- All parent helpers must hold a current Working With Children Check.
- Arrangements regarding parent participation in school programs will be communicated between the relevant teacher and parent helper.
- Levels of parent participation will be monitored by the classroom teacher.
- Teachers will encourage parents to participate in a wide range of school activities.
